ABOUT THE HEALTH MANAGEMENT ACADEMY

The Health Management Academy (The Academy) is made up of a network of executives from the nation's largest integrated health systems and the most innovative health services companies striving to shape the future of healthcare. Since 1998, The Academy has convened executive peer groups, provided leadership development programs, and conducted market research to enhance health system effectiveness and inform strategy. Members leverage The Academy's network to gain national perspective on best-practices that improve care and facilitate transformation.

OUR NETWORK

The Academy's membership includes C-suite and principal leaders from approximately 100 of the nation's largest integrated health systems and 90 forward-thinking health services companies. In a rapidly evolving healthcare environment, these executives recognize that collaboration, partnership, and best-practice sharing will mutually accelerate growth and improve performance in ways that benefit both patients and communities.

The Academy is uniquely focused on health systems with significant scale and community impact. Often participating organizations are the largest employers in their communities and are vital assets of their local economies. Member health systems own or operate 1,800 hospitals with over 333,000 beds and approximately 324 million patient visits annually. With over \$561 billion in total revenue, Academy health systems employ 3.7 million people, including over 200,000 physicians.

OUR SERVICES

Organizations joining The Academy are investing in performance improvement, market intelligence, and professional development. The Academy delivers value through three core areas:



Executive Peer Groups: The Academy facilitates role and topic-based peer groups, connecting executives facing similar challenges and strategic opportunities. By cultivating meaningful, pragmatic relationships, The Academy creates a platform to curate and share expertise. The Academy convenes seventeen executive Forums designed for specific C-suite roles and five Collaborative programs for interdisciplinary teams targeting complex strategic and operational subjects (e.g. population health and cybersecurity).



Leadership Development Programs: The Academy has established renowned leadership development programs including The Academy GE Fellowships and The Academy Physician Leadership Programs. Both program emphasize systems-level thinking and create a national peer network for mid-career healthcare leaders on pace for C-suite health system roles. The programs expose the generation of health system leaders to experienced executives currently shaping healthcare delivery.



Strategic Research: Member-guided strategic research is central to advancing The Academy's education approach. Through quick-hitting surveys and indepth research studies of executives from large integrated health systems, Academy members have access to unique market intelligence for guiding strategic decisions and tactical positioning.
