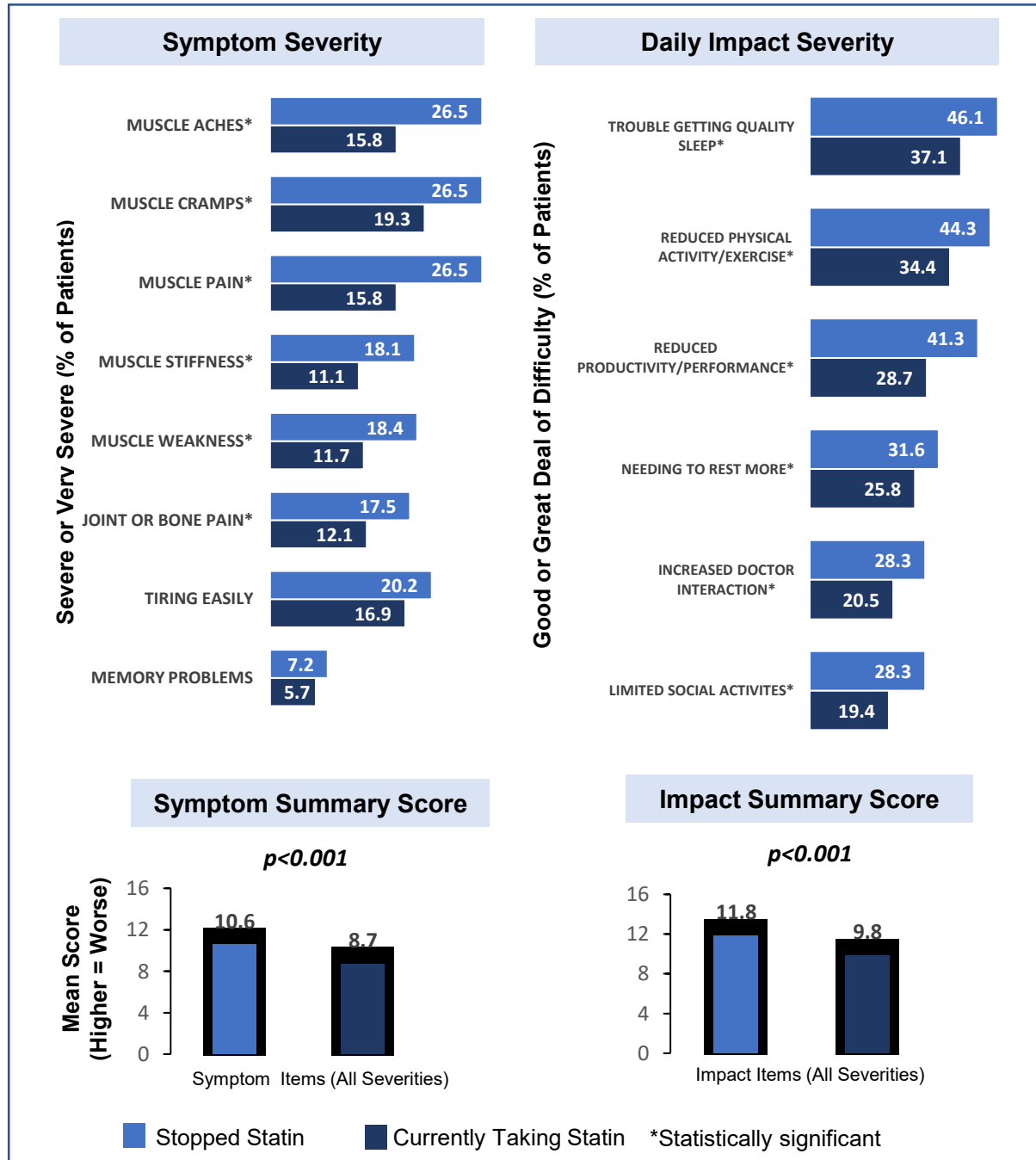


STATIN ADVERSE TREATMENT EXPERIENCE (STATE) SURVEY (N=1,500)



OBJECTIVES

- Describe patients' experiences after recent statin-associated side effects
- Inform clinical practice & encourage benefit-risk discussions
- Identify patients at risk for stopping statin therapy



- ~1 in 5 patients **stopped** taking their statin



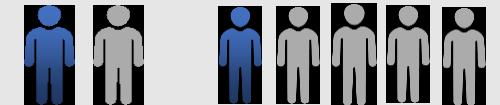
- Top 3 reasons for **staying on statins** (despite side effects)

- Avoiding heart attack or stroke
- Lowering cholesterol
- Doctor recommendation

- Top 3 reasons for **stopping statins**

- Bothered by side effects
- Unable to tolerate side effects
- Side effects interfere too much with daily life

- Among patients who **stopped** taking their statin



~1 in 2 (48%) were not taking anything else to manage their cholesterol

~1 in 5 (22%) stopped without informing their provider

- Patients who stayed on therapy had more statin management than those who stopped (40% vs 24%)
