The NLA offers several different types of membership based on an individual's practice situation and needs.

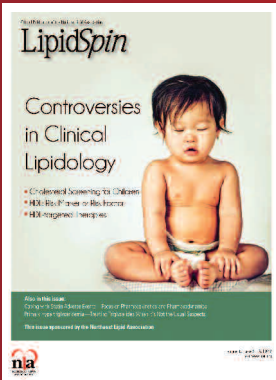
Active Membership

Available to any appropriately credentialed health professional in the United States or Canada who is engaged in the treatment of patients with lipid disorders or involved in research or educational activities relating to lipid disorders, providing that the professional is not employed by a pharmaceutical company or other industry organization.

Fellow/Trainee Membership

A letter from the program director or the school registrant must accompany the application.

Industry Membership

Available to representatives of industry, including physicians and allied health professionals, as an employee or contractor, given that they do not promote or participate in activity directly related to sales or marketing of products or services to members, health professionals, or patients.

NLA members have ample opportunities to work in coordination with other allied health professionals to present, discuss and debate a variety of timely issues.
